- **Mera naam [आपका नाम] hai** (me-ra naam [aap-ka naam] hy): A way to introduce yourself "My name is [your name]." (Image:



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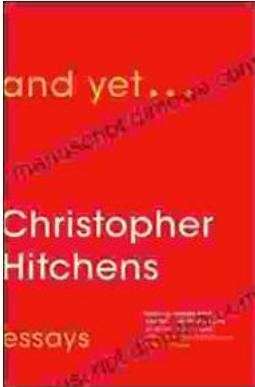
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
