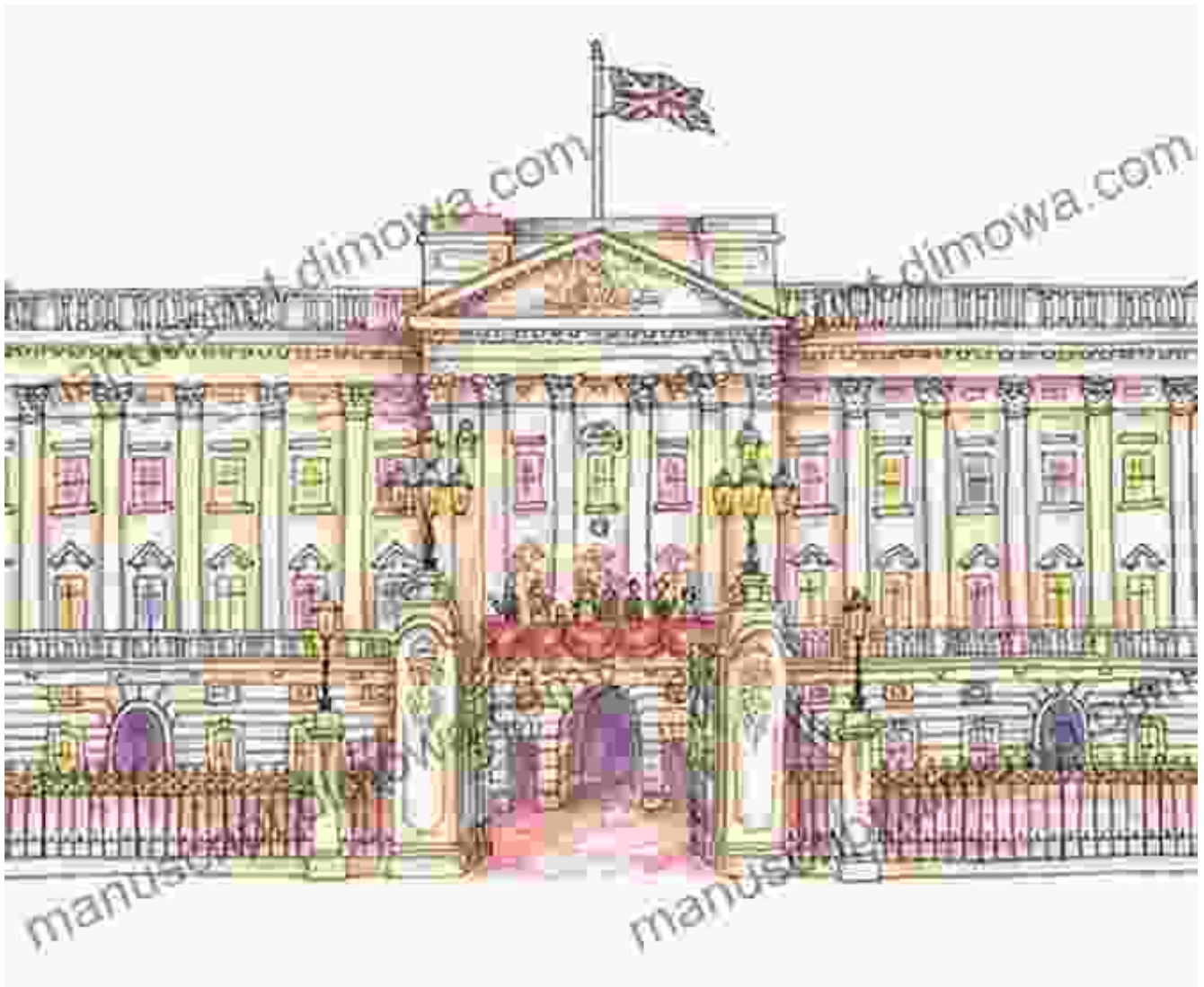

Loch Ness

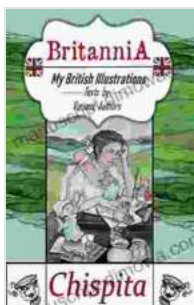

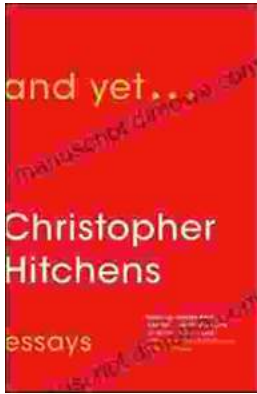
