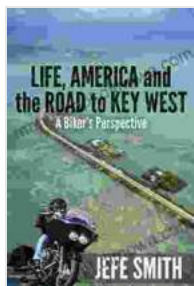


Life, America, and the Road to Key West: A Biker's Perspective

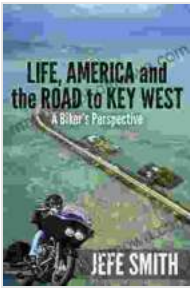
- Learning about the strength of the American spirit

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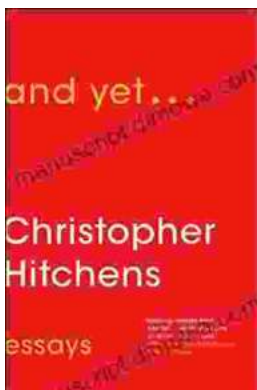
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
